

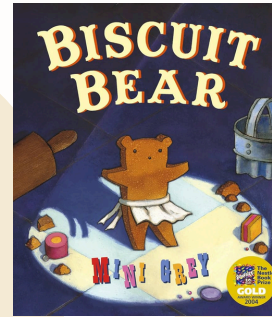
YEAR 2 - KNOWLEDGE PLANNER

AUTUMN 1

LITERACY

This half term we will be reading the book 'Biscuit Bear' by Mini Grey and 'Toby and the Great Fire' by Margaret Nash.

Some of our new learning will include expanded noun phrases and using coordinating conjunctions in sentences. We will be writing descriptions recipes and diary entries!



HISTORY

This half term we are learning all about The Great Fire of London!

The children will be learning when and how the fire began and the events that happened around that time. They will learn about Samuel Pepys and how important his diary entries are to history. They will learn about Tudor buildings, what they were made from and how the fire marked a change to the way houses are built today!



MATHS

Some of the learning this half term will focus on:

- Recognising the place value of a two digit number
- Representing numbers to 100 in different ways
- Comparing and ordering numbers to 100
- Reading and writing numbers to 100 in words and numerals
- Partitioning numbers into tens and ones
- Adding and subtracting one and two digit numbers
- Adding and subtracting 10 from a two digit number

SCIENCE

This half term the children are learning about everyday materials. They will be identifying and comparing the suitability of wood, metal, plastic, glass, brick, paper and cardboard.

The children will make predictions to which materials would best suit a purpose and investigate this. The children will learn the properties of these materials and scientific vocabulary such as opaque and transparent.



COMPUTING

During computing we will be focusing on staying safe online. We will explore effective, safe searching and learning how to share work electronically on display boards.

The children will be introduced to email using Purple Mash 2email to understand how to open and send simple online communications. The children will learn that the information that they put online leaves a digital footprint or trail and to think critically about the information they leave online.



RHE

Our RHE topic is about relationships, being lonely and what makes a good friend.

The children will learn how to make friends with others, how to recognise if they feel lonely and what they can do about it.

Together we will discuss how people behave when they are being friendly and what makes a good friend. They will learn how to resolve arguments that may occur amongst friends and how to ask for help if a friendship is making them unhappy.



PHONICS AND SPELLINGS

We practise phonics and spellings daily using Supersonic Phonics Friends.

The children will have spellings to learn each week for homework. These are set on Seesaw each Friday, the children will then have a spelling check the following Friday.



MUSIC

The children will be learning the history of music, musical genres, musical timelines and influential music people



ART



This half term the children will be exploring the work of the artist, Paul Klee. They will learn about him as an artist and describe the differences and similarities between his pieces.

The children will be using charcoal, pastels and printing to create their own art work in Klee's style.
